Environmental Targets for 2025

Based on our GreenFuture vision and environmental mission statement GoToZero we derived the targets for ŠKODA.

Company

- We intend to become a carbon neutral company by 2050.
- By 2025, we plan to reduce our total life cycle Greenhouse Gas Emissions by 23% compared to 2015.
- We intend to maximize resource efficiency and promote the circular economy approaches in materials, energy, water and land use.
- We aim to become a transparent and successful enterprise in terms of integrity by installing effective management systems covering the environmental impacts of our mobility solutions over all life cycle stages (Environmental Compliance).

GreenProduct

- With our range of environmentally friendly cars, we aim at:
 - Reducing CO₂ [g/km] car emissions to the levels in line with national legislation.
 - Reducing fuel consumption with innovative technical solutions for new cars.
 - Increasing the ratio of recycled and recyclable materials used in production of new cars.
- By 2025, the share of battery electric vehicles in our model portfolio will be 13%.

GreenFactory

- By using innovative technology in production, we aim to reduce the environmental impact by 52,5% till 2025 compared to 2010 (Based on the new Group methodology and the incorporation of PUNE plant):
 - Energy consumption [MWh / car]
 - CO₂ emissions [kg / car]
 - Waste [kg / car]
 - Water consumption [m³ / car]
 - Air emissions, especially volatile organic compounds - VOC [kg / car]
- Environmental burden will be reduced, the company will continue assisting in planting and maintaining green areas.
- We will be also decreasing the amount of materials used and reducing the waste products.
- Environmental pollution will be avoided through implementation of preventative measures.
